DELI PAPER

4 or more sheets.

SUBSTRATE

ONE of the following...

140 pound watercolor paper

Stretched canvas or

A wooden board, no larger than 11" x 14"

Preferably rectangular in shape.

All work well for this process, I prefer the heavy weight of the flat board. Please paint white with gesso or acrylic paint if it's not already white.

SCRAP PAPER-

Phone book pages, old magazine pages work well.

WAXED PAPER

EPHEMERA

Old newspaper clippings, postcards, dictionary pages, letters, journal pages, a nice variety, enough to cover your substrate.

Copies are fine but try to use the original whenever possible.

RAGS

At least 10 small rags.

ACRYLIC GEL MEDIUM

At least 8 oz. Please be aware that this is not the same as liquid matte medium.

ACRYLIC PAINT

At least 4 colors, 2 warm (red, yellow, orange, pink, red)

2 cool (blue, green, purple)

PLUS

Burnt umber.

FW Acrylic INK

Black. This ink is made by Daler Rowney - It is available through Blick and other art suppliers <https://www.daler-rowney.com/fw-acrylic-ink/> for manufacturer information.

BRUSHES

At least one that is 2" wide, a one inch and a detail brush.

PALLETTE KNIFE

A credit card will do in a pinch.

CUP FOR WATER

PVA GLUE

WHITE GESSO

Small amount, maybe 2 oz.

WOODEN SKEWER STICK, SOMETHING that comes to a thin point.
